

Primary Sports and PE Funding 2016-17 review

The planned use of this additional grant is intended to improve the quality of PE and sports provision at Westbourne Primary School.

We will received approximately £9500 in 2016-17. We used this grant to support the development of PE and sport in the following ways.

- To subsidise the cost of a full time sports coach in school
- To support after school PE/sports clubs and tournaments
- To contribute to the cost of residential visits to Ingleborough Hall and Nell Bank for adventurous outdoor activities.
- Providing training in the teaching of PE for school staff.
- To enhance to range of sporting activities offered by the school, including adventurous outdoor activities.
- Enhance provision for sports and PE activities at play time and lunchtime by improved access to equipment.
- Begin to develop whole school fitness based activities to improve general activity levels (Fit School).

What have we achieved through our use of the PE and Sports grant?

Actual costs provided:

- Every class has had the opportunity to take part in an adventurous outdoor activity.
Outdoor adventurous activities: £300 per year group=£1800
- We were able to subsidise two residential visits to Ingleborough Hall=£1000
- The balance has contributed to our school sports coach who has supported the teaching of PE across the school and provided training and support to develop staff expertise in the teaching of PE. =£4927.35
- Children have had the opportunity to take part in inter school sports tournaments outside school hours=£750
- Resources: £1022.65
