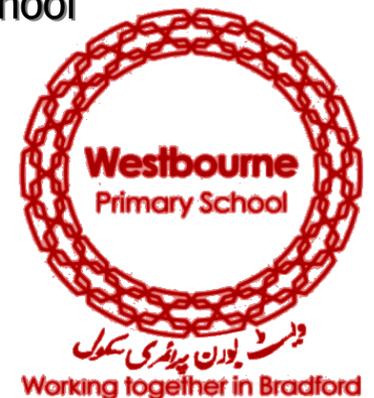
All children are expected to wear the school uniform. Please see the reverse of this document for a visual representation of the uniform.

WESTBOURNE PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIFORM

We advise that boys wear grey trousers along with a white shirt (either cotton or polo) and a burgundy sweatshirt/sweat cardigan with the school logo.

Girls may wear, either a grey or burgundy coloured shalwar-kameez or grey trousers/skirt along with a white shirt (either cotton or polo) and a burgundy sweatshirt/sweat cardigan with the school logo.

If your child prefers to wear a headscarf then only a plain coloured black or white should be worn.
