Subject	Details	How you can help
English	Fairy tales: The children will be describing characters, settings and magical objects	Share your own favourite fairy tales and stories with your child. Talk about why it is a good story, discuss the characters and where the story is set. Find interesting words used to describe things in the story.
Maths	Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Maps Measuring weight and capacity	Talk to your child about directions: North, South, East and West. Look at how different things are measured in everyday life –ml, litres, g, kg.
Science	Materials	Talk about different types of materials and their uses.
ICT	Learning about E-safety, using technology safely and respectfully. Using computer processing programs to present work.	Discuss appropriate use of the internet and why we should not give our personal information.
P.E	Object manipulation Dance	Movements to music rhythm and walk to school.
R.E.	Special Days	Talk about what special days you celebrate and any others you know, for example Diwali and Remembrance Sunday
