
We hope you find this information useful and that it enables you and your family to enjoy supporting your child in their learning at home

Your child should also read for a **minimum** of 20 minutes **every day**.

| Subject | Details | How you can help |
|----------------|--|---|
| English | We will be looking at the text "Mouse Family Robinson" by Dick King Smith. Preparing tool kits for each genre, looking at all the features of particular genres and the appropriate language features and punctuation that should be included. Regular reading, adult lead and independent will take place. Grammar and spelling lessons will be included each week. | Read with your child and ask them questions about the book and fill in the Home Reading Record. Help with spellings. Ask them about what they have been learning. |
| Maths | The focus will be on written method of multiplication and division. The children will be solving open ended problems every week, with a particular focus on perseverance. There will also be lessons on finding fractions of shapes, a set of objects finally finding fractions of a number. | Talk about their work with them. Learn tables by heart. Work through real life problems, including measuring. |
| ICT | E-Safety, including staying safe on the internet and password protection. Alongside this we will learning how to use email safely. We will build on our current knowledge of coding, by writing new codes. | Talk about why we should take care over what we do on the internet. |
| P.E | PE will focus on co-ordination, spending time; throwing and catching a ball, bouncing and catching a ball repeatedly and progressing to juggling with control. | Walk to school every day. Join in Wake Up, Shake Up on a morning before school in the SSA. |
| M.F.L | Recap on previous learning. Learn about days of the week, counting, colours and commands. Basic greetings and introductions. | Talk about their work with them. |
| R.E. | Books that are special to the religions Islam, Christianity and Hinduism. | Discuss books that are important to you and why they are important. |
