Your child **must** read for a **minimum** of 20 minutes **every day**. Your child has been given a reading record which must be regularly filled in.

Individual Set homework for maths will be given by set teachers as required.

Subject	Details	How you can help
English	For reading, children will be looking at a range of texts and using their retrieval and inference skills to understand them. We will also be doing a lot of work on vocabulary and how we can use clues to help us understand new words. In English, children will be studying <i>The Spiderwick Chronicles</i> and using it to inspire their writing. They will be working on setting descriptions, suspense stories and non-chronological reports. Our grammar focus will be on using colons and semi-colons to mark the boundary between independent clauses and using commas to avoid ambiguity.	Read regularly with your child and discuss their books. Please complete their reading records using the next steps we have given. Encourage children to speak in full sentences at home.
Maths	Children will be consolidating their understanding of the four written methods and how to use them to solve problems. The children will then begin working on fractions, decimals and percentages and how they can use the Singapore bar method to solve tricky problems.	Learn passport facts by heart Work through real life problems, including money and time.
Science	In science, we will be exploring living things and their habitats. The children will focus on food chains and classifying animals into different categories. They will also be looking at microorganisms and DNA.	Ask your child about different species of animals and how they fit into the different food chains.
ICT	Espresso Coding: Children will be continuing to use and develop their understanding of coding through the use of the Espresso Coding.	Ask your child what they have learnt when programming and how it influences your every day lives.
P.E	During Year 6, we will be recapping all the sports skills we have developed over time including gymnastics, dance and ball skills.	Encourage outdoor play. And healthy eating and exercise. Walk to school every day.
R.E	Pilgrimage – we will be looking at religious journeys. The three main religions that we are learning about this year are Islam, Christianity and Buddhism.	Ask family members to discuss their experience of Hajj.
M.F.L	Recapping previous learning of family members and where you live.	Ask your child to recall French vocabulary.
