Subject	Details	How you can help
Literacy	Knights and Castles: Researching features of different UK castles, reading stories about castles, dragons and knights Writing our own dragon story.	Help to research castles at home, read stories about knights, castles or dragons. Talk about your favourite stories and story language.
Numeracy	Understanding the value of each digit in a number (place value) Addition, subtraction. Problem Solving and measurement	Reading numbers in everyday life e.g. in the supermarket, newspaper page numbers etc. Asking children to work out calculations in everyday life contexts e.g. adding objects at home.
Science	Uses of everyday materials.	Talk about different types of materials and their uses.
ICT	E-Safety, logging in and word processing skills.	Talk to you child about how to keep safe when using the internet.
P.E	Balance Spatial Awareness	When playing games like 'catch' with your child make sure they are looking for space and changing speed accordingly.
R.E.	Special Days	Talk to your children about special days. Why do you celebrate them? What other special days do you know about?
