Please note that all children should be in school for 8.45am to maximise our 'target time' sessions—every minute counts!

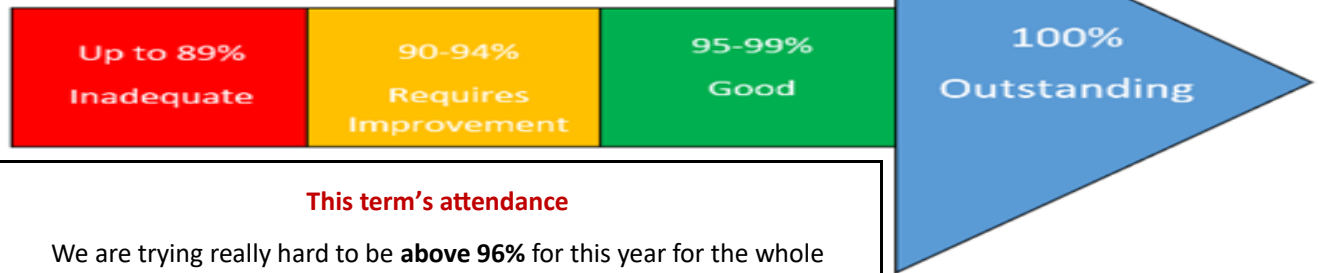
