Parent Information Workshops

Children in Y2 will be assessed across the month of May in line with the statutory assessment requirements for Key Stage 1.

The Key Stage 2 tests are timetabled from Monday 9 May to Thursday 12 May 2022.

Mon 9th May: English grammar, punctuation and spelling papers 1 and 2

Tue 10th May: English reading

Wed 11th May: Mathematics papers 1 and 2

Thursday 12 May: Mathematics paper 3

The Phonics Screening Check for children in Y1 and the Multiplication check for children in Y4 will be completed in June.

We will be holding workshops after the Easter break to share information around the statutory assessment processes with tips for how families can support their children—more information re; dates will be provided to parents of children in Y1, Y2, Y4 and Y6 next week via Weduc.

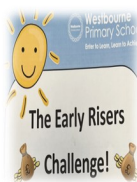


COMMUNITY CHAMPIONS

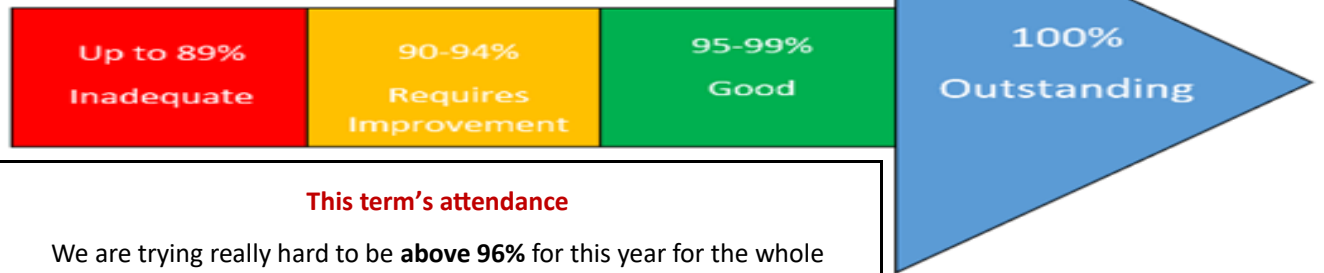
All information regarding key diary dates and events this half term was sent out on Weduc before half term—paper copies are also available from the school entrance.

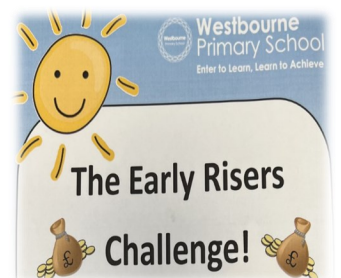


This term's attendance
