Congratulations to Y1 pupils who have carried out their phonics checks this week. Myself and the teachers are very proud of you all.

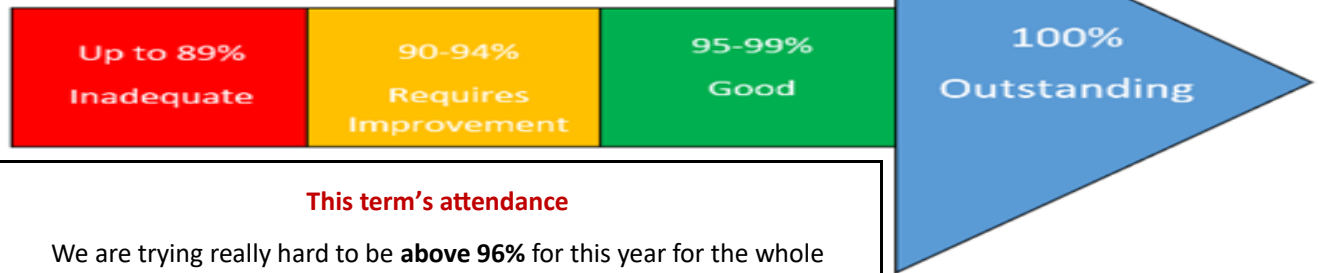
