### Year 6 Elections



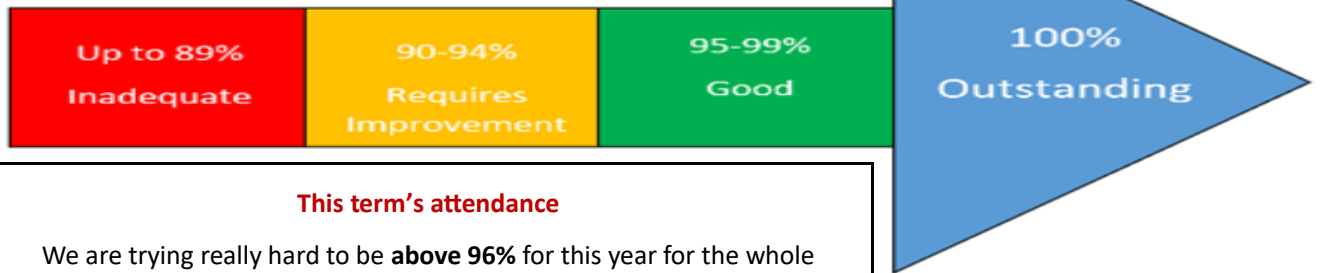
All pupils in year 6 have been given the opportunity to apply for House Prefect positions. Elections will take place next week and the successful candidates will be announced in next week's newsletter.
