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Last week we welcomed lots of new faces to our Parent Partner group. All parents/carers are welcome on Fridays at 9am in the SSA building.

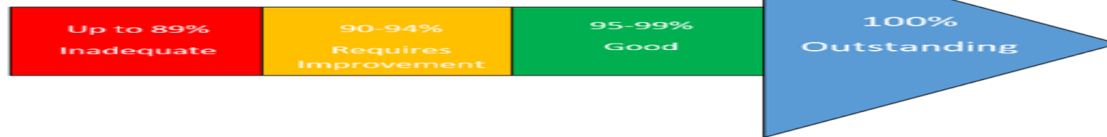
School times and collections
